

As we look forward to celebrating the 500th anniversary of the Protestant Reformation on October 31st, our church family will be memorizing a passage of scripture each month based on one of the 5 Solas (Latin for "alone" or "only), which are foundations of the Reformation. Younger children may choose to memorize just the passages in italics.

AUGUST – *Sola Scriptura: "Scripture Alone"*

2 Timothy 3:16-17

All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

SEPTEMBER – *Sola Fide: "Faith Alone"*

Ephesians 2:8-9

For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

OCTOBER – *Sola Gratia: "Grace Alone"*

Romans 5:1-2

Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Through him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

NOVEMBER – *Solus Christus: "Christ Alone"*

1 Timothy 2:5-6

For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, who gave himself as a ransom for all, which is the testimony given at the proper time.

DECEMBER – *Soli Deo Gloria: "To the Glory of God Alone"*

1 Corinthians 10:31

So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.
